

**Lower Division General Education/Breadth:** Can be completed at the community college using one of the three options listed below. However, completion of general education is not recommended for all majors. *Note: Students wanting to enter a teacher preparation program are advised to see a counselor for general education requirements.* In addition, students in high unit majors such as pre-med or computer science focus primarily on admission requirements and lower division major requirements for the university where they plan to transfer.

- A. CSU General Education: Applies to all CSU campuses, and some private/independent colleges or universities.
- B. IGETC: Applies to all CSU's, most UC's, and some private/independent colleges or universities.
- C. Campus Specific General Education or Breadth Requirements: Consult the specific campus catalog and see your counselor for more information.

**Lower Division Major:** Courses which provide background to prepare students for concentration in their selected major.

**Electives:** Courses of student's choice. Taken when students need courses beyond their lower division general education and major courses to total 56-60 minimum or up to 70 maximum transferable units. Also taken for personal interest.
